

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE ELIZABETHTOWN CITY COUNCIL
APRIL 3, 2017**

The Elizabethtown City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers of City Hall at 4:30 p.m. with Mayor Edna B. Berger presiding.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – MARCH 20, 2017: Minutes of the regular meeting held on March 20, 2017 were previously distributed to each Council Member for consideration. There being no corrections or amendments thereto, it was moved by Council Member Shipp, seconded by Council Member Bennett and carried to adopt the minutes as written.
