# **ORDINANCE NO. 09 - 2017**

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETHTOWN, KENTUCKY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 21-2015 RELATING TO ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Elizabethtown, Kentucky that from and after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance, that Ordinance No. 21-2015 is amended as follows:

# **LICENSE FEES:**

The fee for each of the first five (5) supplemental bar licenses shall be the same as the fee for the primary drink license. There shall be no charge for each supplemental license issued in excess of five (5) to the same licensee at the same premises.

The holder of a nonquota retail malt beverage package license may obtain a nonquota type 4 malt beverage drink license for a fee of fifty dollars (\$50). The holder of a nonquota type 4 malt beverage drink license may obtain a nonquota retail malt beverage package license for a fee of fifty dollars (\$50).

The City ABC Administrator shall transmit fees upon collection to the City Finance Department to be deposited into the appropriate designated account. City licenses shall be issued by the City ABC Administrator upon receipt of notice from the **State** ABC Board Administrator of the finality of appeal or protest permitted upon such license pursuant to the provisions of KRS 243.360, and the fact the ABC Board Administrator has approved the applicant's state license.

#### **CERTAIN SPECIAL LICENSES DEFINED:**

- E. NQ2 Retail Drink License (KRS 243.084): This license authorizes the licensee to purchase, receive and sell [distilled spirits, wine and malt beverages] alcoholic beverages at retail by the drink for consumption on the licensed premises for a restaurant with minimum 50% of gross annual income from food sales and minimum seating capacity of 50 persons at tables. A NQ2 license may be issued to a motel/hotel with a minimum of 50 sleeping rooms, 25,000 square feet of parking, and maintain a restaurant with 50% food sales and minimum seating capacity of 50 people at tables. A NQ2 License can be issued to hotel with 50 sleeping units and 50% food sales from its total food and alcohol sales; a restaurant with 50% food sales from its food and alcohol sales; an airport; a riverboat; a distillery; or a business located within or adjacent to an entertainment destination center license premise.
- F. NQ3 Retail Drink License (KRS 243.086): This license may be issued to [a nonprofit charitable, civic, social, fraternal organization, or political club which has maintained a room from which the general public has been excluded for at least] a private club in existence for longer than one (1) year; a dining car; or a bed and breakfast [or a distiller].
- G. Special Temporary Licenses (KRS 243.260): This license shall authorize the licensee to exercise the privileges of a quota retail drink license and an NQ4 retail malt beverage drink license at designated premises for a specified and limited time and shall expire when the qualifying event ends. All restrictions and prohibitions applying to a distilled spirits and wine quota retail drink license or a NQ4 retail malt beverage drink license shall apply also to a special temporary event. A special temporary license will only be issued to a nonprofit charitable organization or in conjunction with a [n organized charitable,] civic event or community sponsored event, i.e. fairs and festivals. Holidays such as Christmas, Easter and Lent are not considered events.

## **APPLICATION/LICENSE:**

H. Any licenses issued [after August 1] for less than 6 months of any year shall be assessed a fee of ½ of license fee. [which is based on the pro rata portion of the remainder of the license period. However, the cost of any license shall not be less than that for a period of six months.]

## **CONDITIONS, PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS**

I. The licensee shall post in a prominent place easily seen by patrons, a printed sign at least [eleven (11) inches by fourteen (14)] eight and one-half inches (8 ½) by eleven (11) inches in size, [with letters at least one (1) inch high, supplied by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission, and] with gender-neutral language supplied by the Cabinet for Health Services, which shall warn that drinking alcoholic beverages prior to conception or during pregnancy can cause birth defects. A person who violates this subsection shall be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00). KRS 243.895.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor of the City of Elizabethtown and/or her designate be and she is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to perfect this Ordinance.
